

Mandala- Is a decorative pattern filled circle that is symmetrical and balanced. It often contains symbols. Some spiritual traditions use mandalas for meditation or for marking a spiritual space. The word mandala itself simply means "circle" in Sanskrit.





Step 7:

Add layers of textures, images, and words cut from magazines, to your design to tell the viewer something about yourself. You want your design to continue to radiate from the center and still feel balanced. however, you can add some variety to add interest.

> Notice the shapes are similar and repeated but the textures are different. You can be creative here.



Negative shapes are the white space around the skeleton.
